
Is our competition meaningful?

What brings about excessive competition?


What is the relationship between excessive competition and structure unemployment?



A long time ago, there was a village where 100 people lived. This village is dominated by agriculture, everyone is a farmer, they have the same job and the same income.




Because of the loss of twenty workers, the remaining workers do not need so many managers and doctors. Five more people in technical management lost their jobs.









Later, the economy of this town got better and better, and more and more people wanted to come here to gain wealth, and it became a well-known metropolis.
